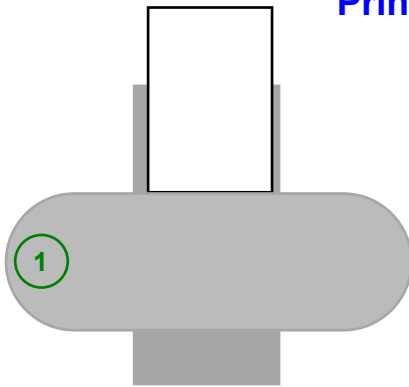
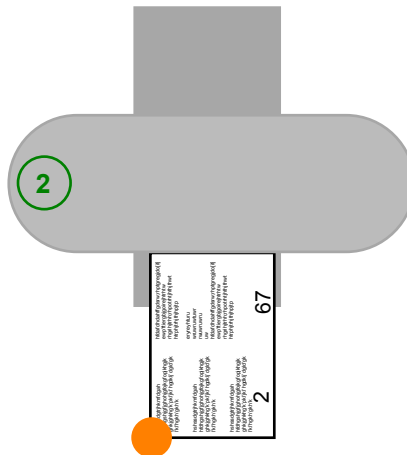


Printing A5 Portrait books double sided

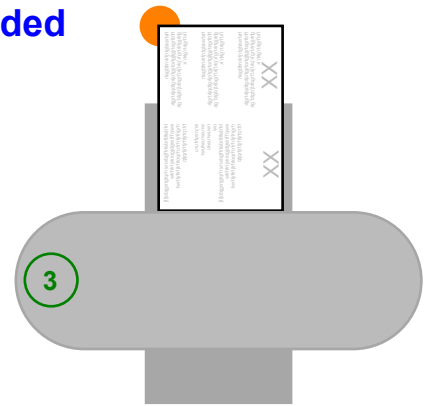


Set the printer to print:
EVEN / REVERSE
Print the pages



The pages will print out with the top of the A5 page to the left, and the page numbers to the right (if the page numbers are on the top of the page, then they will also be on the left).

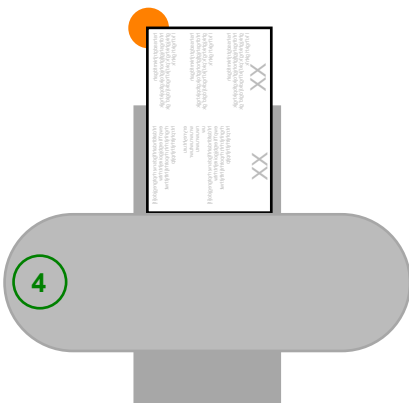
The top sheet will show page number 2 and the second from last page number



Put the pages back in the printer feeder.

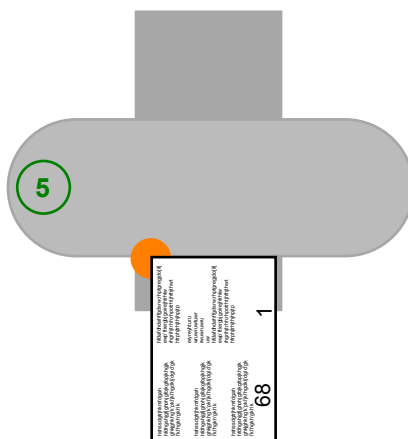
The page numbers should be on the right hand side, and the top of the A5 page on the left side, the plain side of the paper facing forward.

The printed side of the sheet with pages 2 / second from last on will be facing the back of the printer



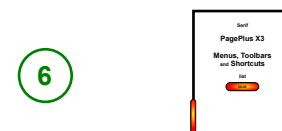
Set the printer to print:
ODD / REVERSE
Print the pages

The sheets are printed in reverse both times so that, when printed, they can be taken from the printer and folded without having to be sorted



The pages will print out with the top of the A5 page to the left, and the page numbers to the right.

The top sheet will show page number the last page number and page 1



Print the cover if you want it.

Place the cover on top of the bundle of pages with the top of the cover aligned with the top of the A5 page. Staple in the centre (a long arm stapler is best for A5 books) and fold over.

You should now have the front page of the cover followed by page 1 when you open the book, with page two on the back of page 1

This example is for top feed printers such as most Epson inkjet printers
The method used for other printers will vary
